Circular

This is for general information for the students of **B. Tech 4**th semester and 6th semester that students those are feeling unsafe to travel because of the current upsurge of COVID – 19 cases throughout the country, may think of reporting on a later date at the institute. Since theory classes will be conducted in online mode, therefore, they will be able to attend the theory classes from their home. However, laboratory classes for those students will be arranged separately later in offline mode, once they are able to report to the campus. End semester examinations will be conducted in offline mode only, after completion of the regular theory classes and once the situation become congenial to conduct the examinations.

Students those are willing to report during the period 17th to 21st January, 2022 following previous circular issued by the Office of the Dean (Acad) (Cir. No. 565, dated 15.12.2021), can report to the campus, following the latest SOP issued by Nagaland Government. As per the latest Nagaland Government SoP, irrespective of the vaccination status, all those students have to carry a negative COVID – 19 test report done through RT-PCR/ TrueNat/ CBNAAT with the swab given for testing not earlier than 3 (three) days of the date of arrival in the state. Because of the current situation, authority may consider giving few days' flexibility for course registration and reporting by those students, if required.

B. Tech 8th semester students and all PG students are requested to report to the campus as per the previous circular issued from the office of the Dean (Academic) (Cir. No. 565, dated 15.12.2021) to complete their pending project and other academic activities for timely completion of courses. They are also requested to strictly adhere to the latest SOP issued by Government of Nagaland and also their respective state SoPs. However, students having some difficulties in course registration and reporting to the campus due to the pandemic situation are requested to inform concerned Head of the department for favour of consideration and record. Depending on the genuineness, Institute will consider such cases positively.

B. Tech 1st semester academic activities will be continued in online mode only and reporting date for this batch of students will be notified later.
